



Ohio Revised Code

Section 5103.609 Placement in residential infant care center for up to 90 days.

Effective: June 13, 2022

Legislation: House Bill 265 - 134th General Assembly

(A) A residential infant care center may provide residential care for up to ninety consecutive days to an infant placed by any of the following with legal custody of the infant:

- (1) A parent, guardian, or legal custodian;
- (2) A public children services agency;
- (3) A private child placing agency.

(B) As used in this section, "legal custody" has the same meaning as in section 2151.011 of the Revised Code.
