Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 111:2-4-03 Political action committee contributions.

Effective: October 5, 2021

Any political action committee that is notregistered under section 3517.107 of the Revised Code shall file a "Designation of Treasurer" prior to receiving contributions or making expenditures for thepurpose of influencing the results of a state or local election in Ohio. Apolitical action committee not registered under section 3517.107 of the RevisedCode and that is registered in a state other than Ohio may not use anycontributions received prior to the filing of the appointment of designation oftreasurer to make expenditures to influence the results of a state or localelection in Ohio.

Once a political action committee has filed anappointment of designation of treasurer pursuant to section 3517.10 of theRevised Code, any contribution received or expenditure made by the politicalaction committee in connection with any state or local election in Ohio shallbe received or made in accordance with Chapter 3517. of the RevisedCode.

Any campaign committee, political action committee, political contributing entity, legislative campaign committee or political party that receives a contribution from a political action committee prior tothat political action committee filing a "Designation of Treasurer" undersection 3517.10 of the Revised Code and this rule shall return the contribution to the political action committee.
