Rule 123:1-70-01 Determination of insurance to be purchased.

(A) The administrator of the office of risk management shall determine what kinds of insurance

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| authorized by law shall be purchased and furnished on behalf of all state agencies except the following: |
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| (1) Boards of elections; |
| (2) Courts of appeals; |
| (3) Courts of common pleas; |
| (4) Supreme court; |
| (5) General assembly; |
| (6) Maintenance of Ohio national guard; |
| (7) Agricultural experimental stations of the state; and |
| (8) Educational institutions of the state. |
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| (B) Nothing in paragraph (A) of this rule precludes any state agency, board, or commission listed in |
| paragraph (A) of this rule, except for educational institutions of the state, from requesting the |
| administrator of the office of risk management to determine what kinds of insurance programs or |
| policies are appropriate for the excepted state agency, board or commission and request that the |
| administrator of the office of risk management purchase and furnish appropriate insurance programs |
| or policies on its behalf. The office of risk management may charge a reasonable fee for the services |

rendered pursuant to this paragraph to the agencies otherwise excepted by paragraph (A) of this rule.
