

Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 1501:46-3-07 Animals in cabin, lodge, golf courses, beach, and camp, facilities prohibited, exceptions.

Effective: May 8, 2020

No person shall bring or keep any animal in anycabin, cabin area, lodge, lodge area, camping area, wildlife display area, orin the water or land area of any beach, swimming pool, or golf courseadministered by the division not designated for that purpose, except that ablind, deaf, or mobility-impaired person may bring or keep a service animal asdefined by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (28 C.F.R. part 35,subpart A, 35.104), especially trained for the purpose of aiding any suchperson, in any area administered by the division. Horsemen may bring or keephorses in areas designated as horseman's campgrounds. Persons may bringdomestic cats and dogs to those sections of the camping areas that have beendesignated by the chief as a camping area zone permitting pets as provided inrule 1501:46-9-10 of the Administrative Code.
