

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3357:15-13-17 Graduation requirements.

Effective: June 7, 2021

A student becomes eligible for an associate degreewhen the student has completed all the requirements of the program that thestudent is enrolled in based upon the catalog-in-force and change of majorpolicy (rule 3357:15-13-28 of the Administrative Code) and as defined by theOhio Department of Higher Education (ODHE). Students must also have a gradepoint average (GPA) of 2.00 or above in their technical major and a cumulativeGPA of 2.00 or above. For programs that do not have technical concentrationcourses, no technical GPA is calculated. Based on accreditation standards, certain programs may require a higher technical and cumulative GPA. The creditstransferred from other institutions must be in accordance with the transfer andarticulation policy (rule 3357:15-13-25 of the Administrative Code) and may beused by a student toward completion of an associate degree at Stark statecollege. Coursework over ten years old is subject to review and acceptance bythe chair of the department offering the course or the dean of that division. However, Stark state college will consider granting permission to a candidateunder a catalog more than ten years old if the candidate has been enrolled continuously and the degree program has not changed appreciably.
