Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3357:15-18-13 Determination of Student Location.

Effective: July 1, 2024

Federal and state regulations require institutions of higher education to determine the state in which a student is located at thetime of the students initial enrollment and/or upon formal receipt of achange of location from the student. The college must determine studentlocation in order to disclose to the student state-specific professionallicensure/certification information for their state of location and discusswhether the educational programs and curriculum at stark state college, which states fy licensure/certification in the state of location.

Stark state college is a member of the nationalcouncil for state authorization reciprocity agreements (NC-SARA), which permits the college to enroll out-of-state students in online educational programs. Acceptance into an educational program or enrollment in course(s) is based onwhere the student is physically located while taking the course(s). This policyapplies to all students taking credit-bearing courses at stark state college including in-person, online, and military students.
