

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3701-54-04 Religious exception.

Effective: May 26, 2020

The provisions of this chapter requiring critical congenital heartdisease screening of newborns and infants do not apply if the parents, guardianor custodian of the child object thereto on the grounds that such screeningconflicts with their religious tenets and practices. Refusal to consent to the critical congenital heart disease screening must be documented in the newbornor infant's medical record and reported to the director.
