



## Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3704-2-02 Grantee criteria for funding.

Effective: [October 18, 2013](#)

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(A) Priority shall be given to grant applicants who develop services in accordance with the mission of the commission pursuant to rule 3704-1-02 of the Administrative Code. To receive consideration for funding, applicants must demonstrate:

- (1) That at least twenty per cent of its funds and/or resources are received from sources other than grants awarded by the commission on minority health;
- (2) Be a public or private nonprofit organization;
- (3) Develop a plan which establishes a management board for the administration of the grant, composed of proportionate representation of the population to be served and submit said plan with the grant application;
- (4) Provide services in close proximity to minority communities or include minority communities in their stated service area; and

(B) The following are ineligible for funding consideration:

- (1) Individuals.
- (2) National organizations. Local chapters or affiliates of national organizations may be eligible if they meet the definition of a "community-based health group" in paragraph (B) of rule 3704-2-01 of the Administrative Code.
- (3) Organizations applying for the sole purpose of acquiring funds to supplement existing programs without any plan for enlarging their scope of work.
- (4) Organizations in the process of creating or starting a community-based health group for the sole



purpose of applying for grants from the commission.

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
