Rule 3745-54-54 Amendment of contingency plan.

Effective: September 29, 2021

- (A) The contingency plan shall be reviewed, and immediately amended if necessary, whenever any of the following:
- (1) The facility's Ohio hazardous waste permit is modified.
- (2) The contingency plan fails in an emergency.
- (3) The facility changes in design, construction, operation, maintenance, or other circumstances in a way that materially increases the potential for fires, explosions, or releases of hazardous waste or hazardous waste constituents, or changes the response necessary in an emergency.
- (4) The list of emergency coordinators changes.
- (5) The list of emergency equipment changes.
- (6) Required by the director.
- (B) A change in the list of facility emergency coordinators or equipment in the contingency plan constitutes a minor modification to the facility's Ohio hazardous waste permit to which the contingency plan is a condition.
