

Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 3769-17-19 Hopples; head pole, restrictions.

Effective: September 2, 2024

- (A) The use of hopples from race to race is in the sole discretion of the trainer, and does not precipitate qualifying the horse.
- (B) No horse will wear hopples in a race unless it starts in the same in the first heat, and having so started will continue to wear them to the finish of the race..
- (C) Any person found guilty of removing, adding, or altering a horse's hopples during a race, or between heat races, may be fined and/or suspended.
- (D) No horse will be permitted to wear a head pole protruding beyond its nose.
