



Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 3769-3-14 No money wagered on first and/or second horse in place pool.

Effective: May 21, 1990

If a horse should be adjudged to have finished first or second in a heat or race, or to be one of the two or more horses adjudged to have finished in a dead heat for first or second position and no money has been wagered on such horse in the place pool, the net place pool shall be distributed to the other class, or among the other classes of purchasers of place tickets entitled to participate in the distribution of the place pool; and, if no money has been wagered on the above classes, then to those who wagered in the place pool on the horse adjudged to have finished third, or to the classes of wagers who wagered on the horses adjudged to have finished in a dead heat for third position. If none of the above, a complete refund of the gross place pool will be made to those who purchased place tickets.
