



Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 4703-2-03 Educational requirements and credits.

Effective: April 15, 2022

All candidates for registration by examination shall:

(A) Hold a professional degree in architecture. A professional degree means an architectural degree in a program which has been accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) or a program that retained its accreditation without revocation to a time twenty-four months or less before the applicant graduated or by the Canadian architectural certification board not later than two years after the degree has been awarded; or

(B) Obtain a report from the Education Evaluation Services for Architects (EESA), as administered by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB), stating that the applicant has met the NCARB education requirement.
