Rule 4717-15-04 Crematory operation certification program requirements.

Effective: May 24, 2018

(A) As used in this division:

Crematory Operation Certification Program means a program approved by the board that includes all of the minimum requirements set by the board and a two hour course on laws and rules relevant to this state and specific to crematory operation. The two hour course may be joined with a program that includes the minimum requirements set by the board.

(B) A crematory operation certification program approved by the board must address with the appropriate depth and competencies required for a crematory operator to safely and effectively work in a cremation facility and shall include at a minimum each of the following required topics:

- (1) Cremation equipment and maintenance;
- (2) Overview of the cremation process;
- (3) Combustion and incineration;
- (4) Shipping, receiving, tracking, and handling of remains;
- (5) Cremation safety and compliance;
- (6) Identification procedures and due diligence;
- (7) Record keeping;
- (8) Risks of liability;
- (9) Environmental laws and regulations;



(10) Occupational safety and health administration laws and regulations (OSHA).
