

Ohio Administrative Code Rule 4725-5-08 Use of license by other.

Effective: August 30, 2019

The permitting of another person to use acertificate of licensure for any purpose constitutes "dishonesty andunprofessional conduct" as that phrase is used in section 4725.19 of theRevised Code. The impersonation of another holder of a certificate of licensure for any purpose constitutes "dishonesty and unprofessional conduct" as that phrase is used in section 4725.19 of the Revised Code. The practice of optometry under any name other than the one under which the certificate of licensure is issued and registered with the exception of a legal name changeconstitutes "dishonesty and unprofessional conduct" as that phrase issued in section 4725.19, of the Revised Code.
