Rule 4758-5-11 Requirements for gambling disorder endorsements.

Effective: July 3, 2023

To receive a gambling disorder endorsement, an individual shall complete the following:

- (A) Submission of formal application.
- (B) Verification of an active independent chemical dependency counselor, chemical dependency counselor III, or chemical dependency counselor II license issued by the board.
- (C) Thirty hours of gambling disorder education with a minimum of four hours completed in each of the following areas:
 - (1) Knowledge of gambling disorder
 - (2) Gambling counseling practice
 - (3) Special issues in gambling treatment
 - (4) Professionalism in gambling treatment
- (D) One hundred hours of compensated work or supervised internship in gambling disorder direct clinical experience.
 - (1) Clinical experience shall be supervised by one of the following:
 - (a) An independent social worker with demonstrated competency in gambling disorder treatment licensed under Chapter 4757. of the Revised Code
 - (b) A professional clinical counselor with demonstrated competency in gambling disorder treatment licensed under Chapter 4757. of the Revised Code



(c) A psychologist with demonstrated competency in gambling disorder treatment licensed under Chapter 4732. of the Revised Code

(d) An independent chemical dependency counselor - clinical supervisor with gambling disorder endorsement licensed under Chapter 4758. of the Revised Code

(e) An independent chemical dependency counselor with gambling disorder endorsement licensed under Chapter 4758. of the Revised Code

(2) An individual may be issued an gambling disorder preliminary endorsement without having complied with paragraph (D) of this rule, but the individual shall comply with paragraph (D) of this rule within two years of issue.

(3) An individual who fails to comply with paragraph (D)(1) of this rule is not entitled to renew the endorsement.
