Rule 4766-3-12 Temporary and disaster operations.

Effective: June 15, 2022

(A) In the event of a disaster situation when permitted ambulance(s) based in the locality of the disaster situation are incapacitated or insufficient in number to render ambulance(s) needed, a licensed ambulance service may utilize whatever means necessary to transport.

(B) An ambulance that has not been issued a permit by the board may be issued a temporary permit, for a period not to exceed sixty days, if the ambulance is used to replace a permitted ambulance that has been temporarily taken out of service for repair or maintenance or is being permanently replaced. In order to obtain a temporary permit, an ambulance service shall submit to the board a request for a temporary ambulance permit using the MTLS online system containing:

- (1) Vehicle identification number of the permitted ambulance;
- (2) Date permitted ambulance was placed out of service; and
- (3) Vehicle identification number of the ambulance to receive a temporary permit.

(C) A temporarily permitted ambulance shall not be operated unless it meets the requirements set forth in paragraph (B) of rule 4766-3-08 of the Administrative Code and the insurance requirement set forth in division (B) of section 4766.06 of the Revised Code.
