

Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 4781-8-05.1 Installation performed by a homeowner.

Effective: January 20, 2020

Notwithstanding rule 4781-8-05 of theAdministrative Code, a homeowner may install a manufactured home for theperson's own occupancy if the manufactured home is located on propertythat the person owns and the home is not located in a manufactured home park. The homeowners must be responsible for all work themselves; however, they maycontract out portions of the work to a division-licensed installer who iscurrently active, and all contracted work must be identified and agreed upon, in writing, on a form prescribed by the division. The division reserves theright to investigate a complaint against a licensed installer for specific workperformed if the scope of work is outlined as the installer's responsibility in writing.
