Rule 5101:6-20-50 State hearings: disqualification from the supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP) based on court action.

Effective: January 17, 2025

- (A) If a court finds that an individual committed an intentional program violation, the local agency will disqualify the individual in accordance with the court order.
- (B) Prior to implementing the disqualification, the local agency will provide the individual a JFS 04062 "Notice of Disqualification for Intentional Program Violation," or an approved Ohio department of job and family services equivalent, in accordance with rule 5101:6-20-18 of the Administrative Code.
- (C) If the court fails to impose a disqualification or a disqualification period, the local agency will impose a disqualification period, in accordance with rule 5101:6-20-03 of the Administrative Code, unless contrary to the court order.
- (D) If the court orders disqualification but fails to specify a date for initiating the disqualification period, the period will begin within forty-five days of the date of the court order.
