Rule 5160-10-27 DMEPOS: continuous passive motion (CPM) devices.

Effective: January 1, 2024

(A) Coverage.

- (1) No particular form or format is specified for the certification of medical necessity.
- (2) Payment may be made for the rental of a continuous passive motion (CPM) device to be used in a personal residence, beginning within forty-eight hours after total knee replacement surgery or the surgical revision of a total knee replacement, for a period not to exceed twenty-one days. On the prescription for the device, the first date and last date of use are indicated.
- (3) Separate payment may be made for the purchase of one complete set of accessories (e.g., pads, straps, hook-and-loop closures) if the individual does not already have such accessories as a result of previous use of a CPM device.

(B) Constraints and limitations. No payment is made for a CPM device in any of the following circumstances:

- (1) The device is used on a joint other than the knee;
 - (2) The device is used as a substitute for conventional physical therapy; or
 - (3) Neither the individual nor anyone assisting the individual is able to operate the device or is willing to follow the necessary post-surgery rehabilitation regimen.
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
