

Ohio Administrative Code

Rule 5180:2-9-44 Family preservation center.

Effective: January 1, 2023

- (A) A family preservation center (FPC) certificate is obtained by a facility actively being licensed first as either a children's crisis care facility, or a residential infant care center, and by meeting the qualifications outlined in this rule.(B) A FPC is to obtain and maintain accreditation under one of the following:
- $(1) \ The \ commission \ on \ \ accreditation \ of \ rehabilitait on \ facilities.$
- (2) The joint commisson on accreditation of healthcare organizations.
- (3) The council on accreditation for children and family services.
- (C) The FPC is to obtain and maintain certification by the Ohio department of mental health and addiction services.
- (D) A FPC is to provide family preservation programs informed by evidence-based or promising practices, including all of the following;
- (1) Family case management.
- (2) Service referral and linkage.
- (3) Parent education.
- (4) Trauma screening and healing-centered interventions.
