

## Ohio Administrative Code Rule 901:13-1-12 Placing and sloughing.

Effective: April 1, 2016

Each owner, operator, or person responsible foragricultural operations shall prevent pollution caused by placing soil directlyinto or in such a position that it may readily erode or slough into waters of the state. Agricultural operations found by the director or the director's designee to have failed to implement best management practices (BMPs) to prevent sloughing of soil and have caused pollution to waters of the stateshall apply and maintain BMPs to prevent soil sloughing from occurring. Agricultural operations shall not use earth disturbing practices, including tillage, immediately adjacent to waters of the state such that the disturbedsoil is placed or may readily erode or slough into waters of the state, except for those practices constructed or implemented in accordance with generally agricultural and engineering practices.
