## **Denial of Release for Birth Parent**

Section 3107.46 of the Ohio Revised Code states a birth parent, who did not check the "no" space provided on the form completed as part of the adoption process or birth parent, who signed an authorization of release form, may rescind that form by filing a denial of release form. Two items of identification, such as motor vehicle driver's or commercial driver's license identification card, marriage application, social security card, credit card, military identification card, or employee identification card, must be submitted with the denial of release.
