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## AMENDED APPENDIX

Appendix to rule 3745-51-20 of the Administrative Code

**Representative Sampling Methods** 

The methods and equipment used for sampling waste materials vary with the form and consistency of the waste materials to be sampled. Samples collected using the sampling protocols listed below, for sampling waste with properties similar to the indicated materials, are considered by Ohio EPA to be representative of the waste.

The following are newer approved equivalent methods:
