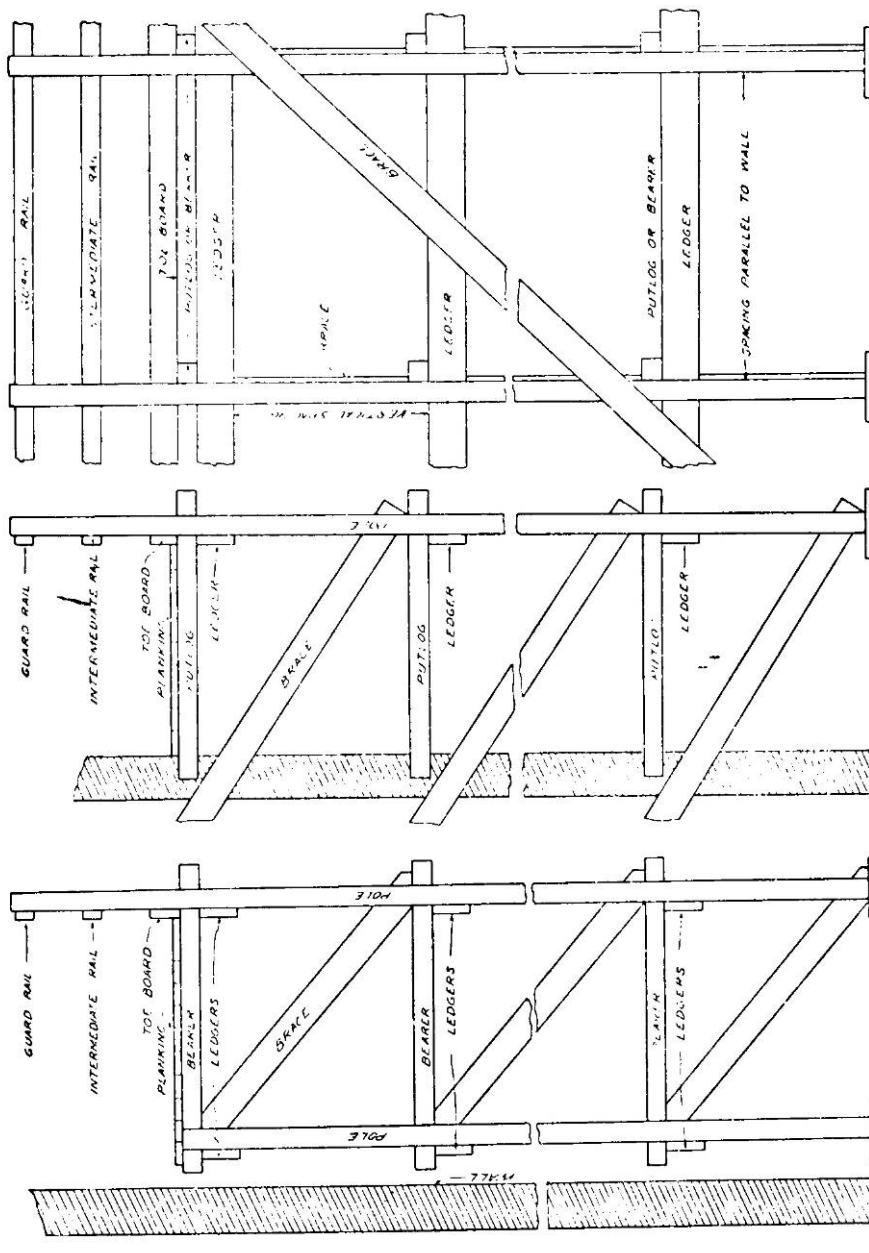


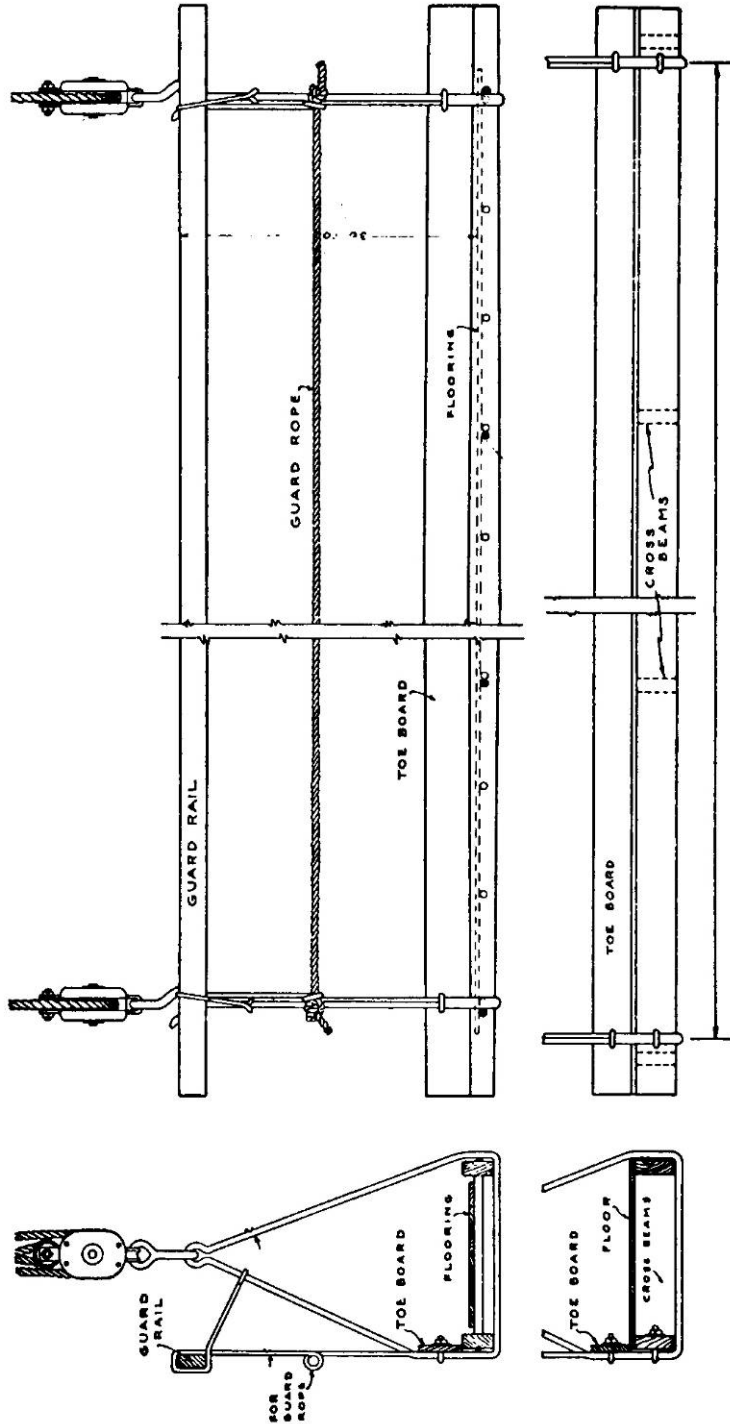

Pole Scaffold—Single and Double Type.



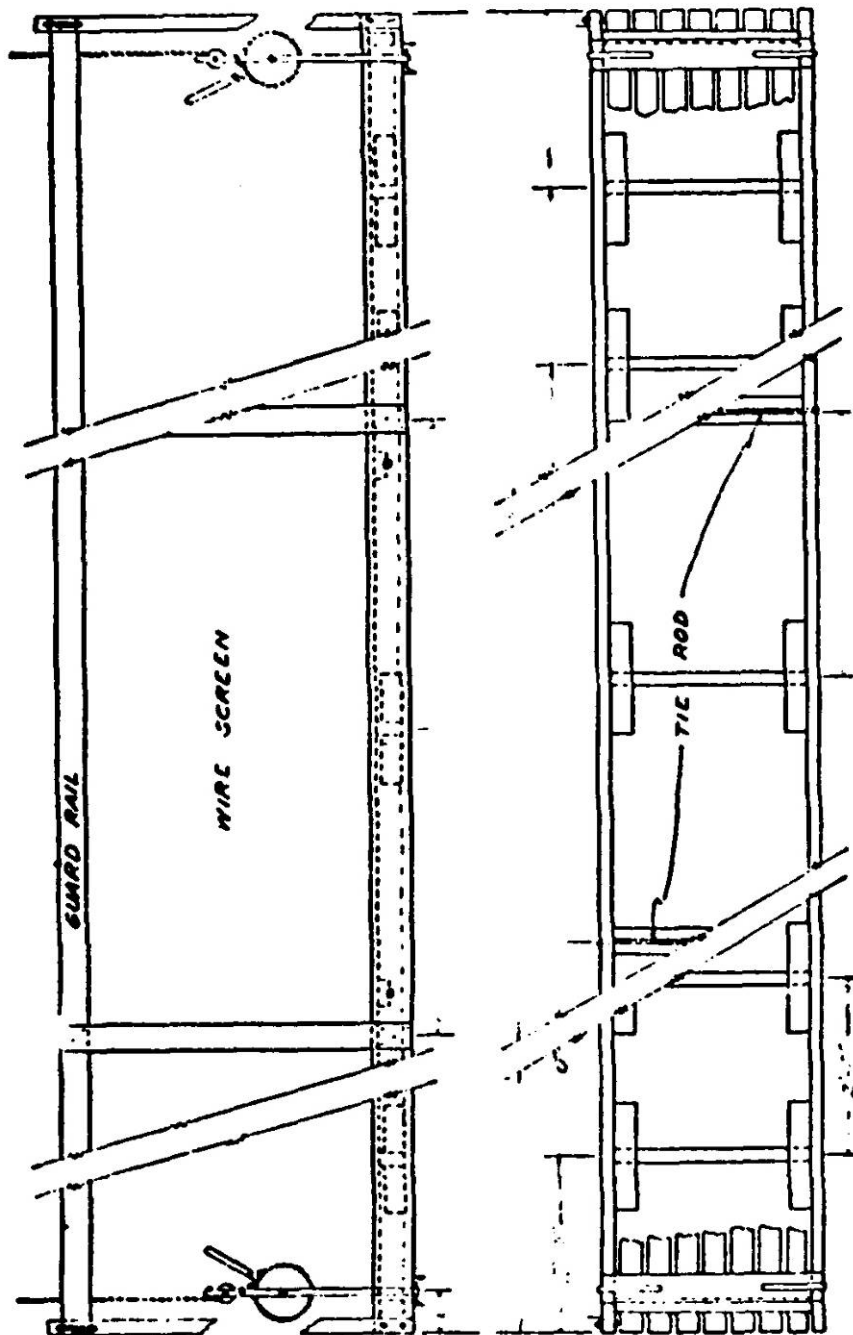

Swinging Scaffold—Ladder Platform and Longitudinal Beam Type.

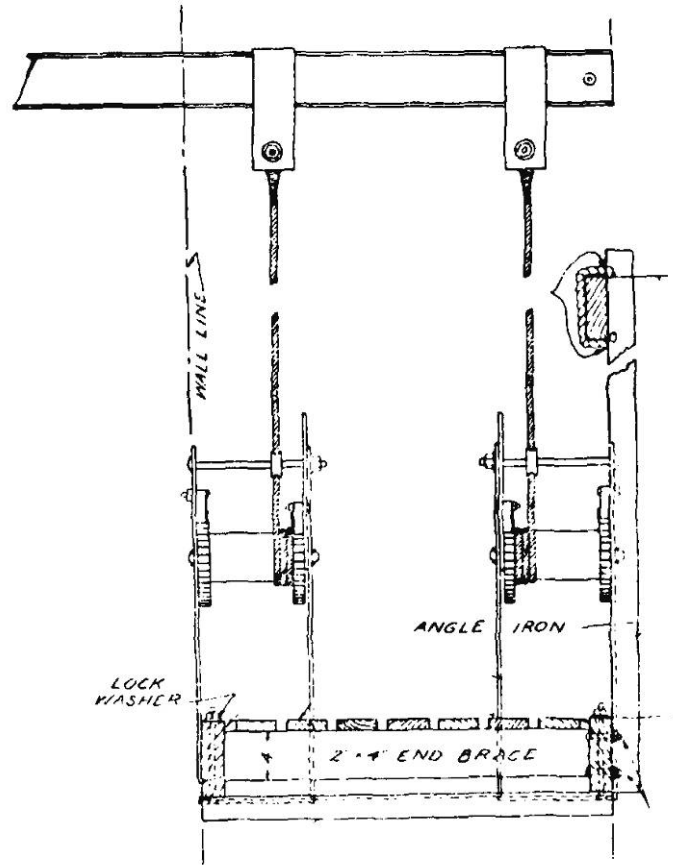

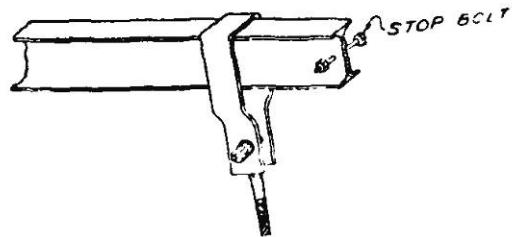
Suspended Scaffold.

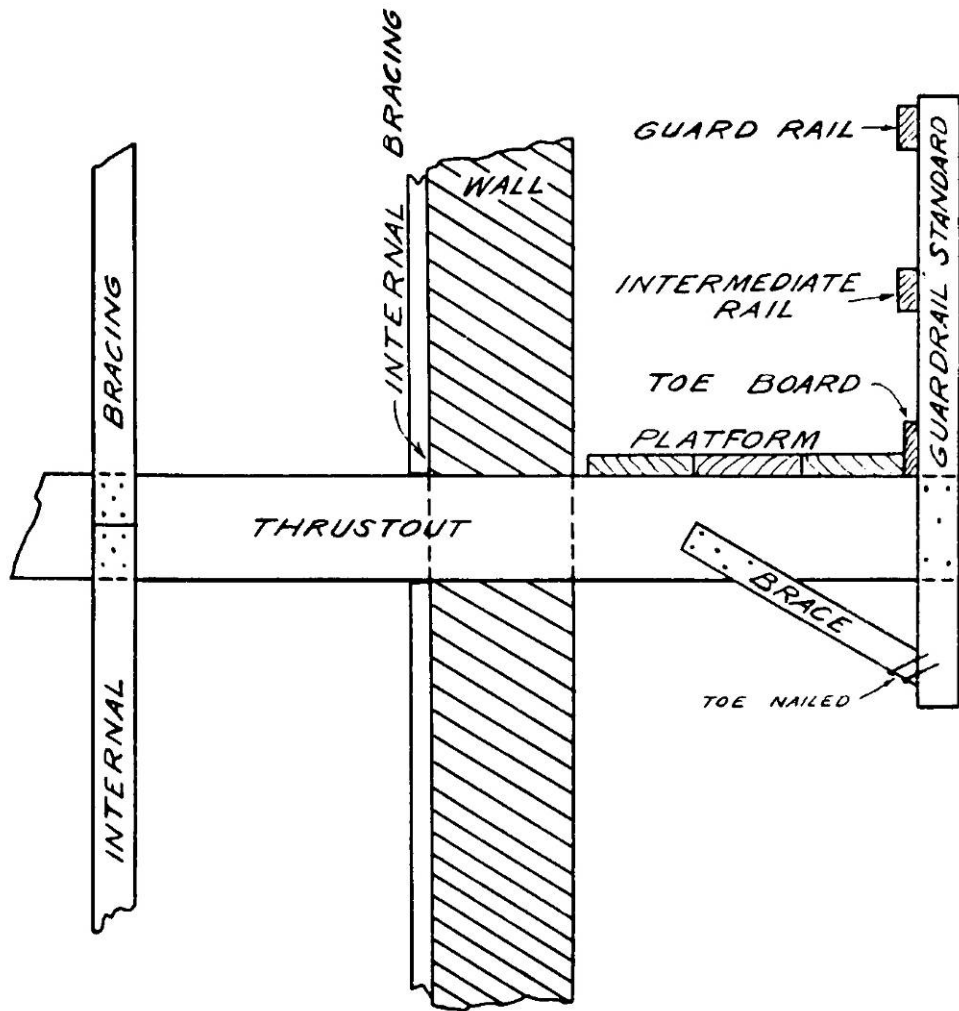


End View of Suspended Scaffold.

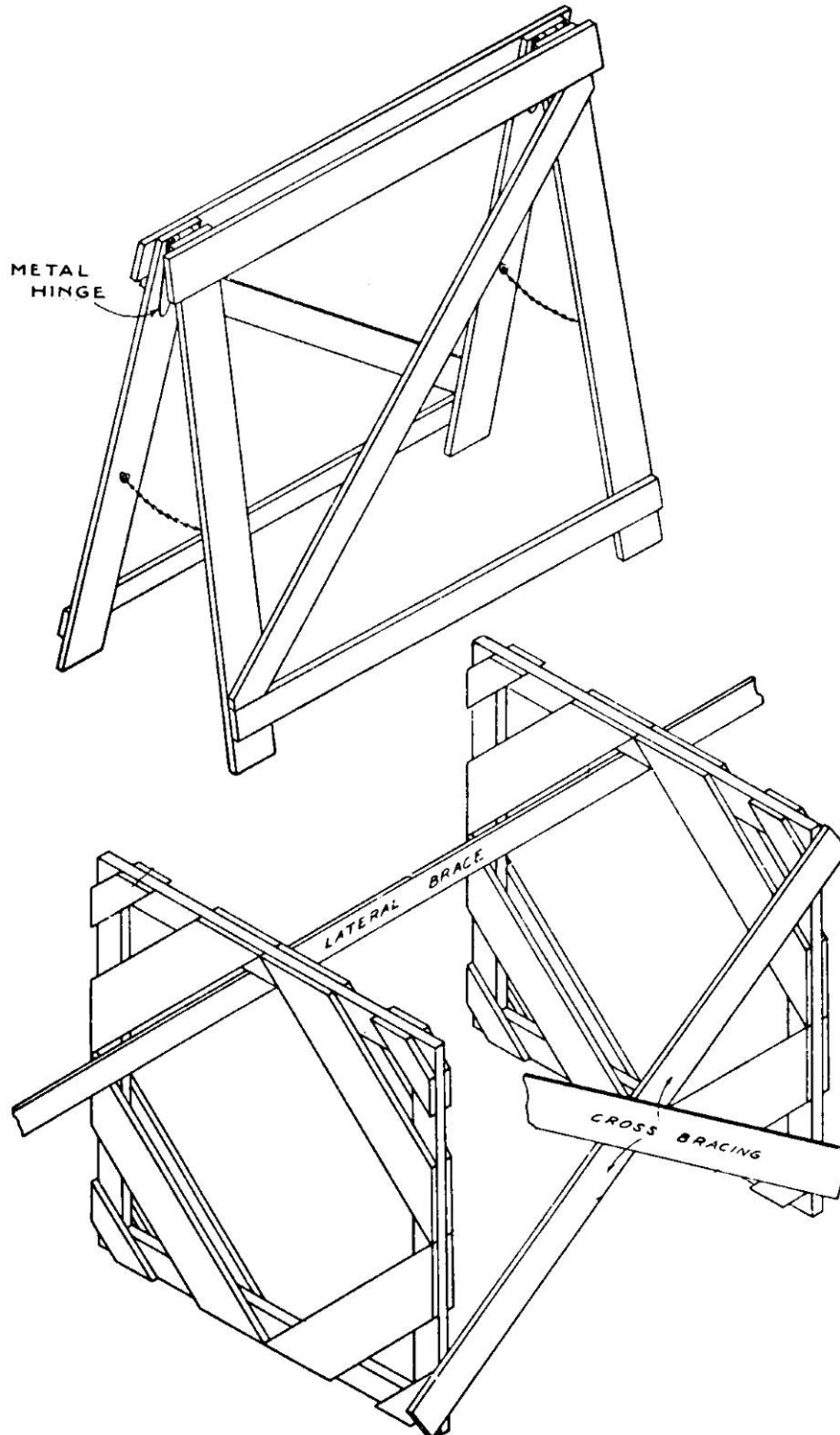

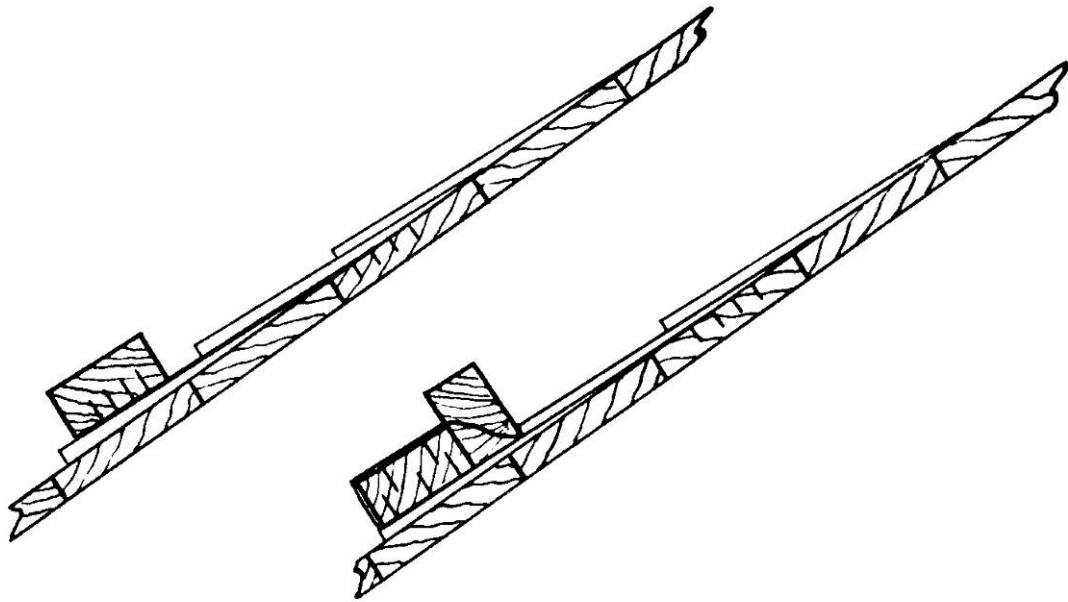
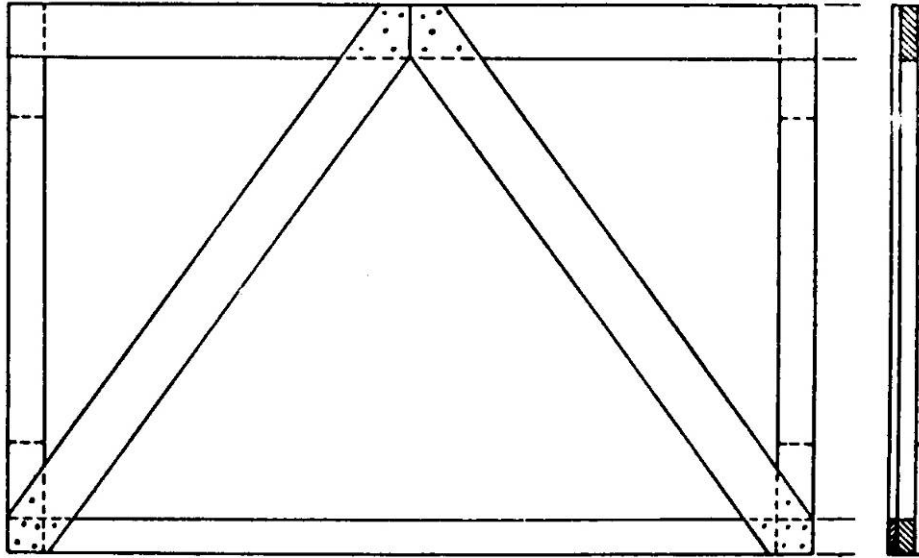

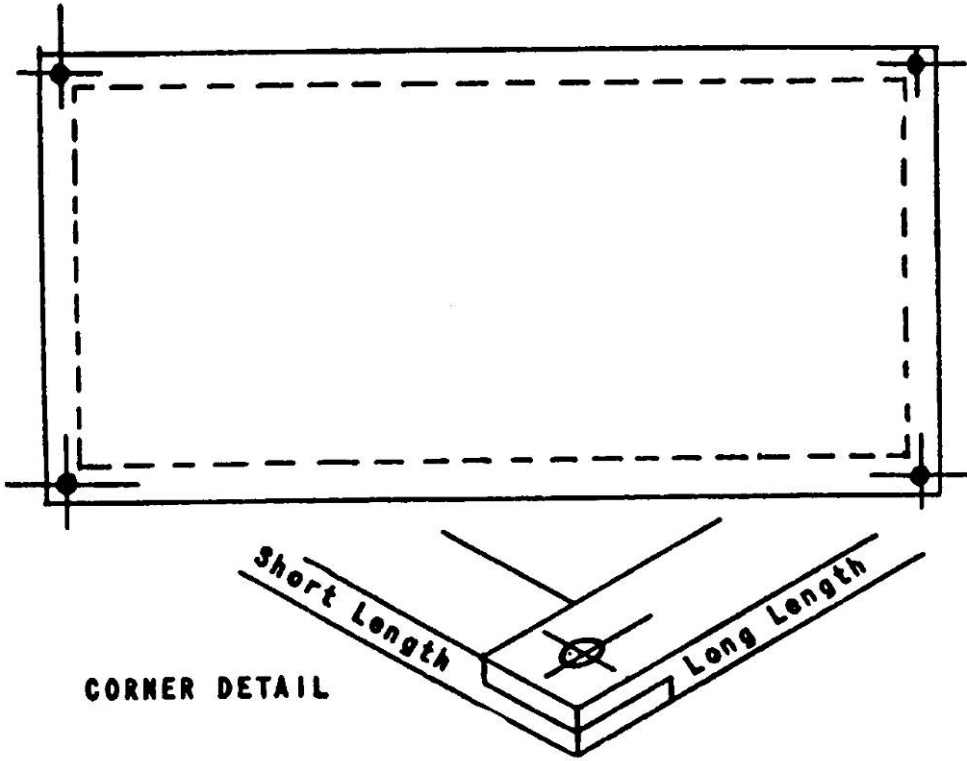

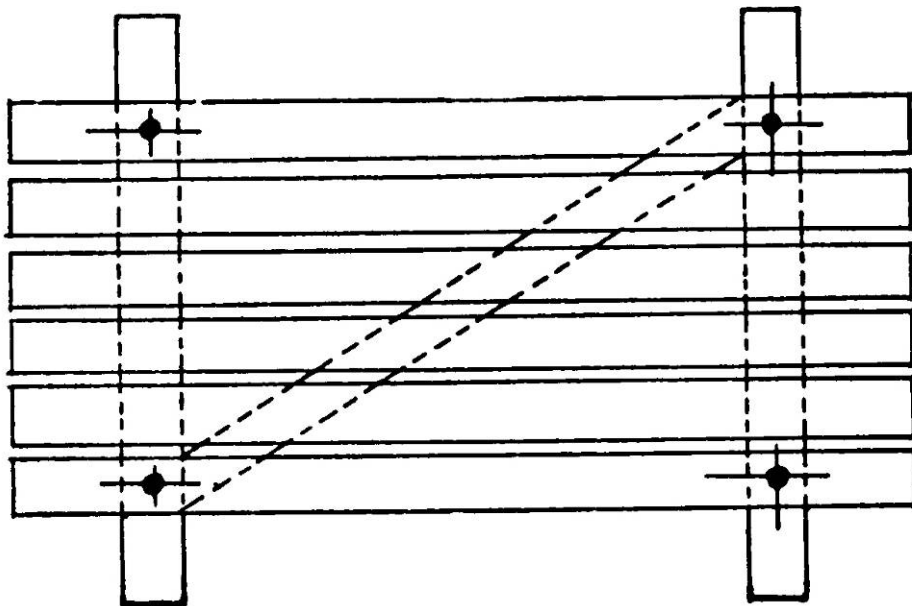

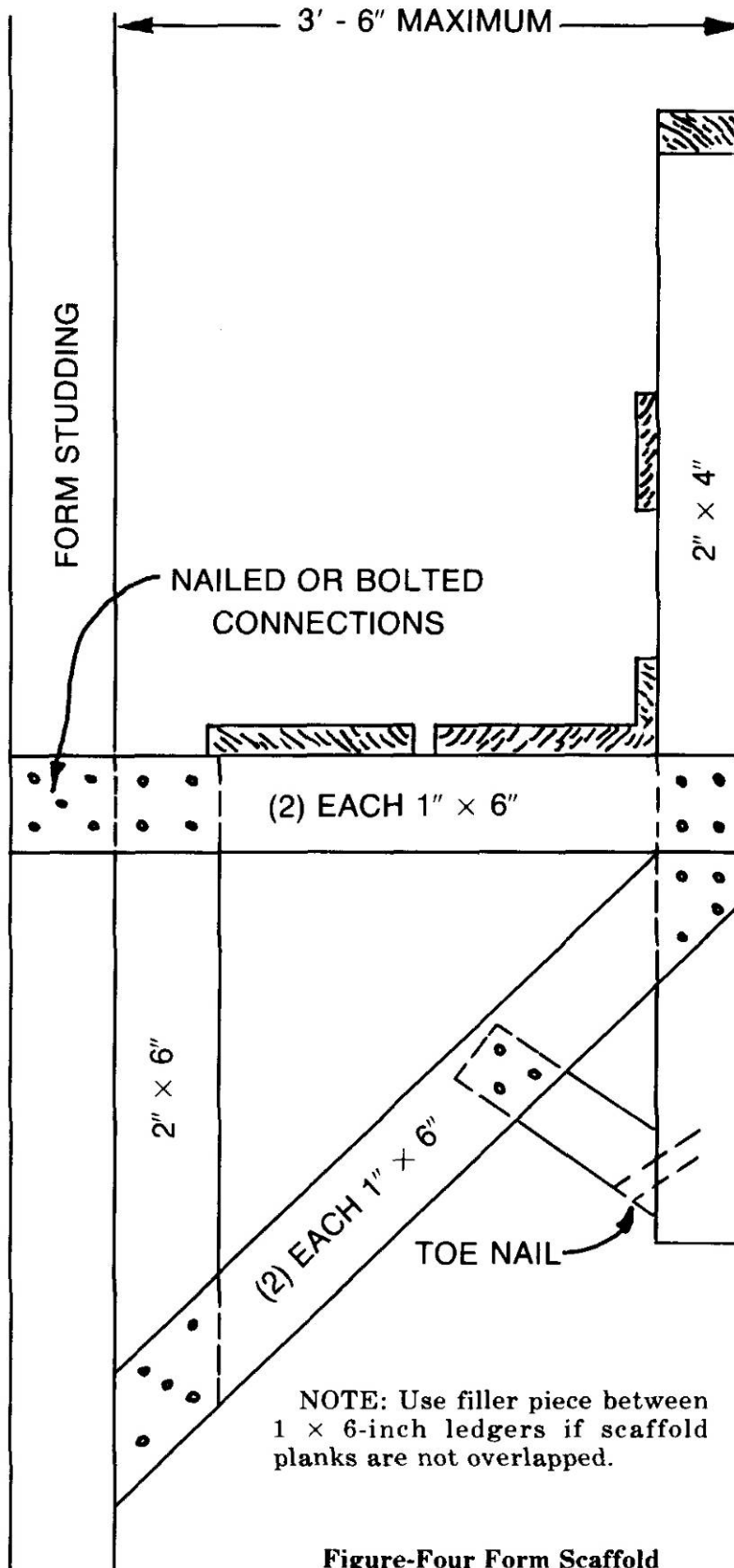
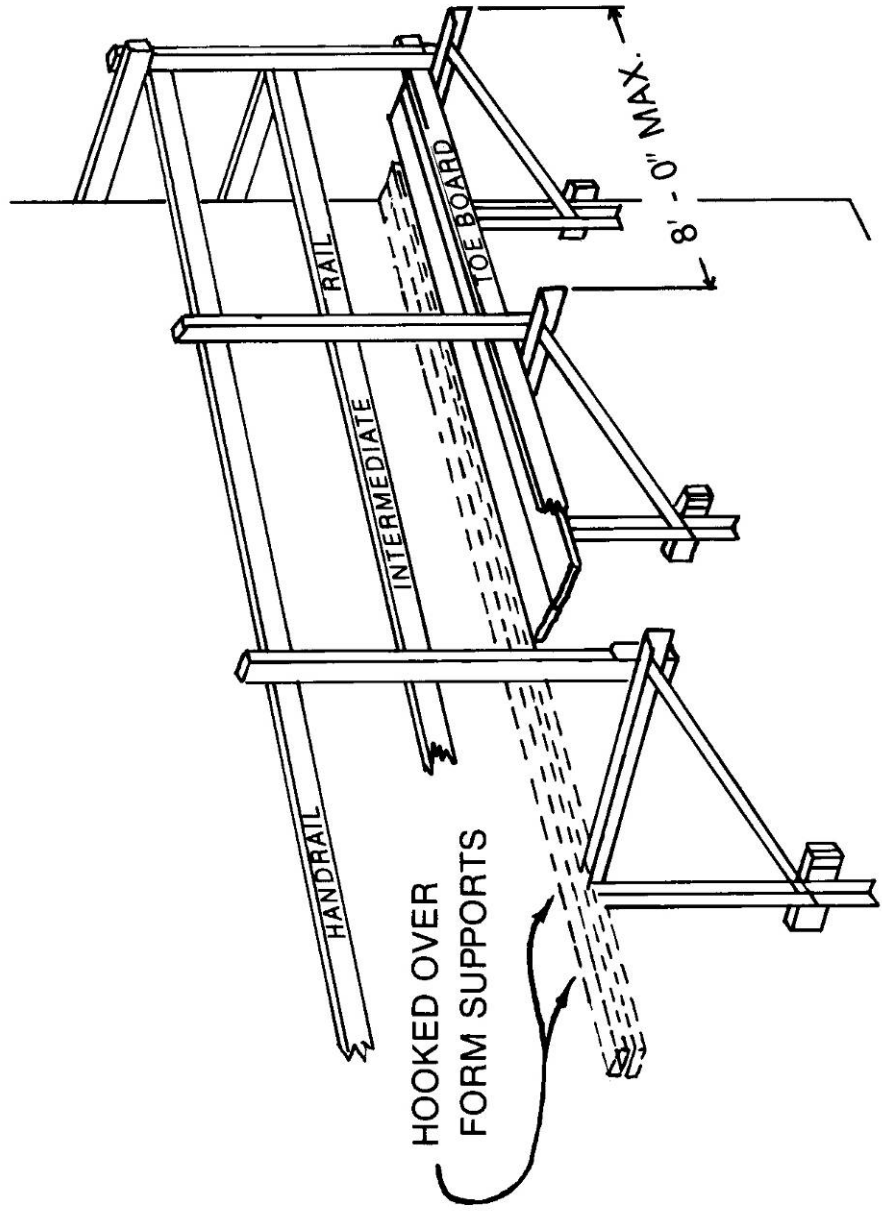


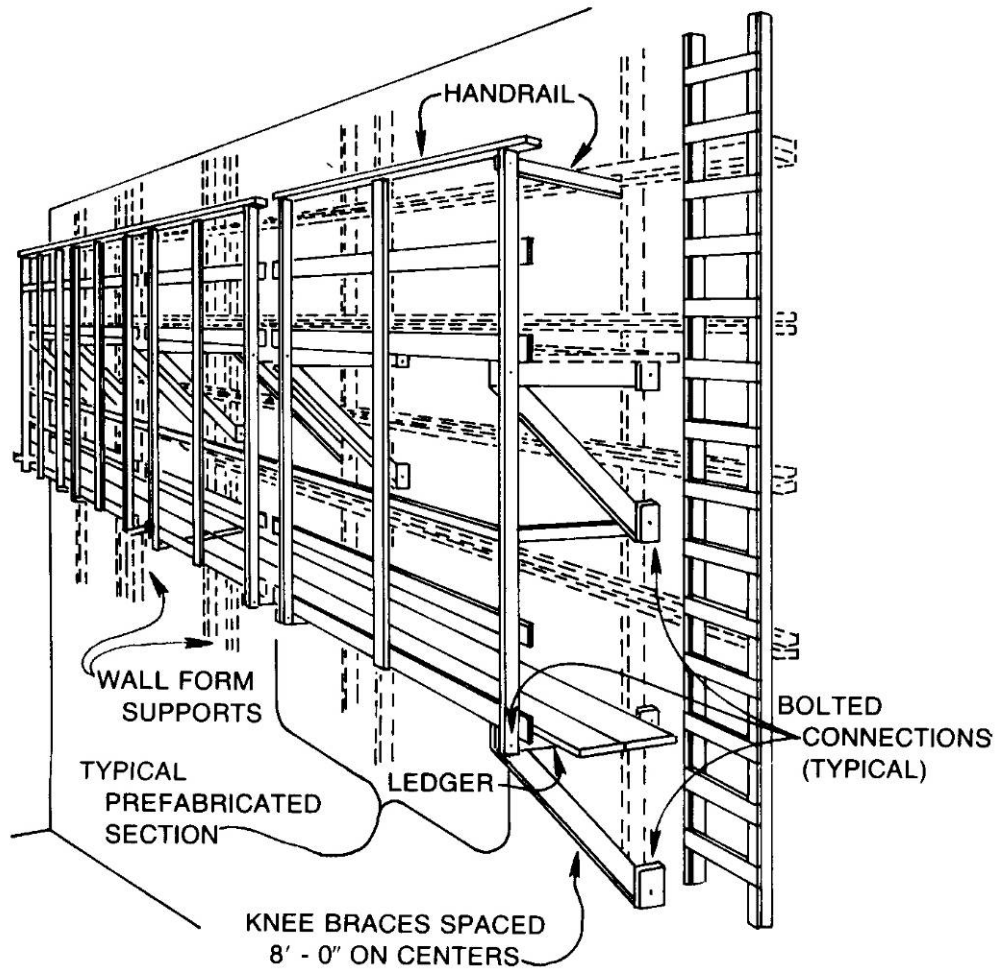
Figure-Four Form Scaffold
