## 3358:11-2-55 Academic misconduct policy.

**ACTION: School** 

- (A) Purpose. Owens community college seeks to maintain a learning environment that is free from academic misconduct. Academic misconduct is dishonest or unethical behavior that misrepresents one's involvement in an academic assignment, course grade, or related task. It is a student's responsibility to demonstrate academic honesty and conduct. where students are expected to conduct themselves with integrity and honesty, both personally and professionally. The following standards are outlined and are promulgated in the associated procedures of this rule.
  - (1) Defines expected behavior.
  - (2) Articulates prohibited behavior.
  - (3) Describes the disciplinary process.
  - (4) Outlines possible sanctions.
  - (5) Provides an opportunity for appeal.
- (B) Application: This rule applies to all students.
- (B)(C)—Implementation. The <u>chief academic officer</u> <u>office of the provost</u> will implement procedures, guidelines, and forms, which are consistent with the provisions of this rule.
