3358:11-3-11 Student conduct policy.

- (A) Purpose. Owens community college seeks to maintain a learning environment where students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that supports the academic atmosphere of the college and respects the rights of other students and employees. The establishment of a conduct system with clear standards, which:
 - (1) defines expected behaviors,
 - (2) articulates prohibited behavior,
 - (3) describes the disciplinary process,
 - (4) 4) outlines possible sanctions,
 - (5) 5) provides for due process rights, and 6) provides an opportunity for appeal are promulgated in the associated procedures by the vice president, student services.
- (B) Application. This policy applies to <u>credit-seeking</u> all full time and parttime students, both credit and non-credit students.
- (C) Implementation. The <u>chief student affairs officer or designee(s)</u> <u>vice</u>

 <u>president, student services</u> will implement procedures, <u>guidelines, forms</u>

 <u>and operational processes, which are</u> consistent with the provisions of this

 <u>rule</u>, <u>policy as well as communicate said procedures to students.</u>
