



Ohio Revised Code

Section 2101.17 Fees from county treasury.

Effective: January 1, 1976

Legislation: Senate Bill 145 - 111th General Assembly

The fees enumerated in this section shall be paid to the probate court from the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor which shall issue upon the certificate of the probate judge and shall be in full for all services rendered in the respective proceedings as follows:

(A) For each hearing to determine if a person

is a mentally ill individual subject to

hospitalization when the person is committed

to a state hospital or to relatives

(B) When the person is discharged

.....7.00;

(C) For order of return of a mentally ill person

to a state hospital or removal therefrom

.....2.00;

(D) For proceedings for committing a person to an

institution for the mentally retarded



.....10.00;

(E)For habeas corpus proceedings when a person

is confined under color of proceedings in a

criminal case and is discharged

.....10.00;

(F)When acting as a juvenile judge, for each

case filed against a delinquency ,

dependent, unruly, or neglected child, or a

juvenile traffic offender

.....5.00;

(G)For proceedings to take a child from parents

or other persons having control thereof

.....5.00.
