Section 2715.21 Powers and duties of receiver.

Effective: August 26, 1982

Legislation: House Bill 254 - 114th General Assembly

The receiver appointed under section 2715.20 of the Revised Code shall take possession of all notes, due bills, books of account, accounts, and other evidences of debt, that have been taken by the levying officer as the property of the defendant in attachment, and proceed to settle and collect them. For that purpose, the receiver may commence and maintain actions in his own name, as receiver, but no right of defense therein shall be impaired or affected.
