Section 4758.44 Prevention consultant certificate requirements.

Effective: March 22, 2013

Legislation: House Bill 284 - 129th General Assembly

An individual seeking a prevention specialist II certificate shall meet the requirements of division (A) or (B) of this section.

- (A) To meet the requirements of this division, an individual must meet all of the following requirements:
- (1) Have at least six thousand hours of compensated work experience in alcohol and other drug prevention services, including at least four thousand hours of administering or supervising the services;
- (2) Hold from an accredited educational institution at least a bachelor's degree in a field of study specified in rules adopted under section 4758.20 of the Revised Code;
- (3) Have at least one hundred hours of prevention-related education that meets the requirements specified in rules adopted under section 4758.20 of the Revised Code;
- (4) Have at least the number of hours of administrative or supervisory education specified in rules adopted under section 4758.20 of the Revised Code;
- (5) Pass one or more examinations administered pursuant to section 4758.22 of the Revised Code for the purpose of determining competence to practice as a prevention specialist II.
- (B) To meet the requirement of this division, an individual must hold, on December 23, 2002, a certificate or credentials that were accepted under former section 3793.07 of the Revised Code as authority to practice as a certified prevention specialist II.
